- Areas with ≥ 5 sightings of ≥ 5 birds recorded over any 2yrs, or
- Single sightings of ≥ 40 or more birds
- A two kilometre (km) radial buffer was applied to these records
- NSW State Vegetation Type Map (SVTM) used to select Plant Community Types (PCTs) associated with the swift parrot within the 2km buffers to create the important habitat map.
- The area of swift parrot important habitat is based on records from 1991 (25 individuals) and 1992 (6 individuals) from a location at Douglas Road, Blacktown where the current Tyndale Christian School is located.
