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Part A – Conditions specific to the action	
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<i>As varied on the date this instrument was signed</i>	1. To minimise impacts to the Striped Legless Lizard , the approval holder must not: a. clear more than 4.05 hectares (ha) of Striped Legless Lizard habitat within the site ; and b. clear outside of the site .
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<i>As varied on the date this instrument was signed</i>	2. The approval holder must a. submit a Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) to the department for the Minister's approval to avoid and mitigate harm to protected matters within the site . b. not commence the Action unless the Minister has approved the CEMP in writing. c. must commence implementing the CEMP approved by the Minister prior to the commencement of the Action . d. continue to implement the approved CEMP until the completion of the Action .

The CEMP must be consistent with the Environmental Management Plan Guidelines , and must include: a. details of the relevant protected matters and a reference to EPBC Act approval conditions to which the plan refers,
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- b. a table of commitments made in the plan to achieve the environmental outcomes, and a reference to exactly where these commitments are detailed in the plan,
 - c. commitments capable of ensuring that the environmental outcomes are achieved,
 - d. management measures to avoid and mitigate **harm to Striped Legless Lizards**, including artificial lighting management and a relocation protocol to safely relocate any **Striped Legless Lizard** individual away from an area of clearing or construction by a **fauna spotter catcher**,
 - e. reporting and review mechanisms to demonstrate compliance with the commitments made in the plan,
 - f. an assessment of risks relating to achieving the environmental outcomes and risk management strategies and/or mitigation measures that will be applied to address identified risks,
 - g. impact avoidance, mitigation and/or repair measures, and the timing of those measures, and
 - h. a monitoring program, which must include:
 - i) performance indicators,
 - ii) triggers values for corrective measures,
 - iii) the timing and frequency of monitoring, ensuring monitoring is capable of detecting trigger values and changes in the performance indicators.
 - i) Details describing the **Package 1C Early Works** including,
 - i) a map, **shapefile** and details specifying:
 1. The location and extent of where **clearing** will be undertaken
 2. The location and extent of **Striped Legless Lizard habitat** and **Striped Legless Lizard** exclusion fencing to provide a minimum 5-meter buffer from **Striped Legless Lizard habitat**.
 - ii) details of sub plans to the CEMP that will be used to implement **Package 1C Early Works**.

Offset requirements

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

- 5. To compensate for the residual significant impact on **Striped Legless Lizard**, the approval holder must submit to the **department** for approval by the **Minister** an Offset Management Plan (OMP). The approval holder must not undertake any **clearing, construction** or other physical activity associated with the Action outside of the **Package 1C Early Works Boundary** unless the OMP is approved in writing by the **Minister**. The approval holder must implement the approved OMP from the date of approval by the **Minister** and continue to implement the approved OMP at least until the expiry date of this approval.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

6. The OMP must meet the requirements of the **Environmental Offsets Policy** and the **Environmental Management Plan Guidelines** to the satisfaction of the **Minister**. All commitments, including environmental outcomes, management measures, corrective actions, trigger values and performance indicators in the OMP must be **SMART** and based on referenced or included evidence of effectiveness.

The OMP must be prepared by a **suitably qualified ecologist** and must include:

- a. detailed information on the residual impacts to **Striped Legless Lizard** that will be compensated for by the offset (comprising both the **securement** of all offset sites and the **habitat quality** improvements to be achieved at each offset site), including all areas of habitat, and the **habitat quality**, for **Striped Legless Lizard** at all locations impacted by the Action which the offset is to address,
- b. the relevant **protected matters** and a reference to the **EPBC Act** approval conditions to which the OMP refers,
- c. detailed information and a **shapefile** specifying the location, area and boundaries of each offset site,
- d. detailed baseline information on the areas of the habitat, and the **habitat quality**, for **protected matters** at each offset site,
- e. achievable offset outcomes, relevant to the conservation of **Striped Legless Lizard**, for each offset site and the timeframes in which they will be achieved,
- f. a table summarising all commitments to achieve the offset outcomes for **protected matters** at each offset site and a reference to where each commitment is detailed in the OMP,
- g. reporting and review mechanisms to inform the **department** annually regarding compliance with the implementation of management measures and the attainment and maintenance of the offset outcomes,
- h. an assessment of risks to achieving each offset outcome and what risk management measures and/or strategies will be applied to address these,
 - i) a monitoring program, which must specify:
 - ii) measurable performance indicators and the timeframes for their achievement to gauge attainment of each offset outcome for the **protected matters**.
 - iii) trigger values for corrective actions, and
 - iv) the proposed timing (including season/time of day/frequency) methods and effort, and an explanation of how these will be effective for this purpose, of monitoring to detect trigger values, changes in the performance indicators and to gather evidence that effectively demonstrates actual progress towards, attainment of and maintenance of all offset outcomes for the protected matters,

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- i. corrective actions to be implemented to ensure all offset outcomes for the **protected matters** are achieved or maintained if trigger values are reached or performance indicators are not achieved in the specified timeframes,
 - j. references to related plans and conditions of approval,
 - k. how each offset site will be protected, including **securement**, and all offset outcomes maintained or improved, at least until the expiry of the approval.

7. To compensate for the residual impacts of the Action on **Striped Legless Lizard**, the approval holder must provide written evidence of the initiation of **securement** of all offset sites specified in the approved OMP before undertaking any **clearing, construction** or other physical activity associated with the Action outside of the **Package 1C Early Works Boundary** and provide written evidence of final **securement** within 18 months of the **commencement of the Action**.

8. The approval holder must achieve all offset outcomes for each offset site specified in the approved OMP by the time specified in the OMP. Once achieved, the approval holder must maintain or exceed the offset outcomes at least until the expiry date of this approval. From the date of approval of the OMP the approval holder must:
- a. have each offset site assessed annually by a **suitably qualified ecologist** to determine if the offset outcomes specified in the OMP have been achieved
 - b. submit to the **department** a report prepared by a **suitably qualified ecologist** detailing the presence of **Striped Legless Lizard** and **habitat quality** of and their habitat within each offset site within 20 business days after each **ACR period**, and
 - c. notify the **department** in writing of any offset outcomes that has not been achieved at all offset sites and the likely reasons that this/these offset outcomes have not been met.
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Part B – Standard administrative conditions

Revision of action management plans

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

9. The approval holder may, at any time, apply to the **Minister** for a variation to an action management plan approved by the **Minister** by submitting an application in accordance with the requirements of section 143A of the **EPBC Act**. If the **Minister** approves a revised action management plan (RAMP) then, from the date specified, the approval holder must implement the RAMP in place of any previous version of the action management plan.

Notification of date of commencement of the action

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

10. The approval holder must notify the **department** electronically, within 5 **business days** of the date of:

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- a. **commencement of the Action**, following **commencement of the Action**.
 - b. Undertaking the first instance of any on-site **clearing, construction** or other physical activity associated with the Action outside of the **Package 1C Early Works Boundary**.
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As varied on the date this instrument was signed

11. The approval holder must not **commence the Action** later than 15 March 2027.

Compliance records

12. The approval holder must maintain accurate and complete **compliance records** and document the procedure for recording and storing **compliance records**.

13. If the **department** makes a request in writing, the approval holder must provide electronic copies of **compliance records** to the **department** within the timeframe specified in the request.

Note: Compliance records may be subject to audit by the **department**, or by an **independent auditor** in accordance with section 458 of the **EPBC Act**, and/or be used to verify compliance with the conditions. Summaries of the results of an audit may be published on the **department's** website or through the general media.

Submission and publication of plans

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

14. Wherever these conditions require the approval holder to submit any **plan** to the **department**, all such **plans** must be submitted to the **department** electronically.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

15. Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the **Minister**, the approval holder must publish each **plan** on the **website** within 15 **business days** of the date:

- a. the **plan** is approved by the **Minister** in writing, if the **plan** requires the approval of the **Minister**,
 - b. the **plan** is submitted to the **department** in accordance with a requirement of these conditions, if the **plan** does not require the approval of the **Minister**.
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As varied on the date this instrument was signed

16. The approval holder must keep all **plans** published on the **website**, in a format that is easily accessible and downloadable, from the first date which that **plan** must be published and until the expiry date of this approval. This requirement applies to all current and superseded versions of **plans**.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

17. The approval holder is required to exclude or redact **sensitive ecological data** from any version of a **plan** before that **plan** is published on the **website** or otherwise provided to a member of the public. If **sensitive ecological data** is excluded or redacted from a **plan**, the approval holder must notify the **department** in writing what exclusions and redactions have been made in the version published on the **website**.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

18. The approval holder must ensure that any **monitoring data** (including **sensitive ecological data**), surveys, maps, and other spatial and metadata required under the conditions of this approval are prepared in accordance with the *Guidelines for biological survey and mapped data*, Commonwealth of Australia 2018, or as otherwise specified by the **Minister** in writing.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

19. The approval holder must ensure that any **monitoring data** (including **sensitive ecological data**), surveys, maps, and other spatial and metadata required under the conditions of this approval are prepared in accordance with the *Guide to providing maps and boundary data for EPBC Act projects*, Commonwealth of Australia 2021, or as otherwise specified by the **Minister** in writing.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

20. The approval holder must submit all **monitoring data** (including **sensitive ecological data**), surveys, maps, other spatial and metadata and all species occurrence record data (sightings and evidence of presence) electronically to the **department** within 20 **business days** following the end each **ACR period** except where otherwise specified in a **plan**.

Annual compliance reporting

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

21. The approval holder must prepare a **compliance report** for each **Annual Compliance Report period (ACR period)**.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

22. The approval holder must ensure each **compliance report** includes:

- a. accurate and complete details of compliance and any non-compliance with:
 - i) each condition attached to this approval decision, and
 - ii) all commitments made in each **plan**,
- b. a schedule of all **plans** in effect in relation to these conditions during the **ACR period**,
- c. accurate and complete details of how each **plan** was implemented during the **ACR period**, and
- d. if any **incident** occurred, accurate and complete details of each **incident**.

23. The approval holder must ensure each **compliance report** is completed to the satisfaction of the **Minister** and is consistent with the *Annual Compliance Report Guidelines*, Commonwealth of Australia 2023.

24. The approval holder must, within 20 **business days** following the end each **ACR period**, in a format that is easily accessible and downloadable, publish on the **website**:

- a. each **compliance report**, and
- b. a **shapefile** showing all **clearing of protected matters**, and their habitat, undertaken within the **ACR period**.

25. The approval holder must:
- a. Exclude or redact **sensitive ecological data** from each **compliance report** and **shapefile** published on the **website** or otherwise provided to a member of the public.
 - b. If **sensitive ecological data** is excluded or redacted from a version of a **compliance report** published or otherwise provided to a member of the public, submit the full **compliance report** to the **department** within 5 **business days** of its publication on the **website** and notify the **department** in writing what exclusions and redactions have been made in the version published on the **website** or otherwise provided to a member of the public.
 - c. If **sensitive ecological data** is excluded or redacted from a version of a **shapefile** published or otherwise provided to a member of the public, submit the full **shapefile** to the **department** within 5 **business days** of its publication on the **website** and notify the **department** in writing what exclusions and redactions have been made in the version published on the **website** or otherwise provided to a member of the public.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

26. The approval holder must notify the **department** electronically, within 5 **business days** of each date of publication that the **compliance report** has been published on the **website**. In this notification, the approval holder must provide the **department** with the web address for where the **compliance report** and related **shapefile** are published on the **website**.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed

27. The approval holder must keep each **compliance report** and related **shapefile** published on the **website** from the first date which that **compliance report** must be published and until the expiry date of this approval.

Note: **Compliance reports** may be published on the **department's** website.

Reporting non-compliance

28. The approval holder must notify the **department** electronically, within 2 **business days** of becoming aware of any **incident**. The approval holder must specify in each notification:
- a. any condition or commitment made in a **plan** which has been or may have been not complied with,
 - b. a short description of the **incident**, and
 - c. the location (if applicable, including co-ordinates), date and time of the **incident**.

29. The approval holder must provide to the **department** in writing, within 12 **business days** of becoming aware of an **incident**, the details of that **incident**. The approval holder must specify:

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- a. all corrective measures and investigations which the approval holder has already taken in respect of the **incident**,
 - b. the potential impacts of the **incident**,
 - c. the method and timing of any corrective measures that the approval holder proposes to undertake to address the **incident**, and
 - d. any variation of these conditions or revision of a plan that will be required to prevent recurrence of the **incident** and/or to address its consequences.
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Independent audit

34. The approval holder must submit an **audit report** to the **department** for written agreement from the **department** within 3 months following the end of each **audit period**, or as otherwise directed by the **Minister** in writing.

35. The approval holder must ensure each **audit report** is completed to the satisfaction of the **Minister** and is consistent with the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 Independent Audit and Audit Report Guidelines*, Commonwealth of Australia 2019.

36. The approval holder must publish each **audit report** on the **website**, in a format that is easily accessible and downloadable, within 10 **business days** of the date of the **department** agrees to the **audit report** in writing.

37. The approval holder must notify the **department** within 5 **business days** of the date the **audit report** is published on the **website**. In this notification, the approval holder must provide the **department** with the web address for where the **audit report** is published on the **website**.

As varied on the date this instrument was signed 38. The approval holder must keep each **audit report** published on the **website** from the first date which that **audit report** must be published and until the expiry date of this approval.

Completion of the action

Within 20 **business days** after the **completion of the Action**, and, in any event, at least 20 **business days** before this approval expires, the approval holder must notify the **department** electronically of the date of **completion of the Action** and provide **completion data**. The approval holder must submit any spatial data that comprises **completion data** as a **shapefile**.

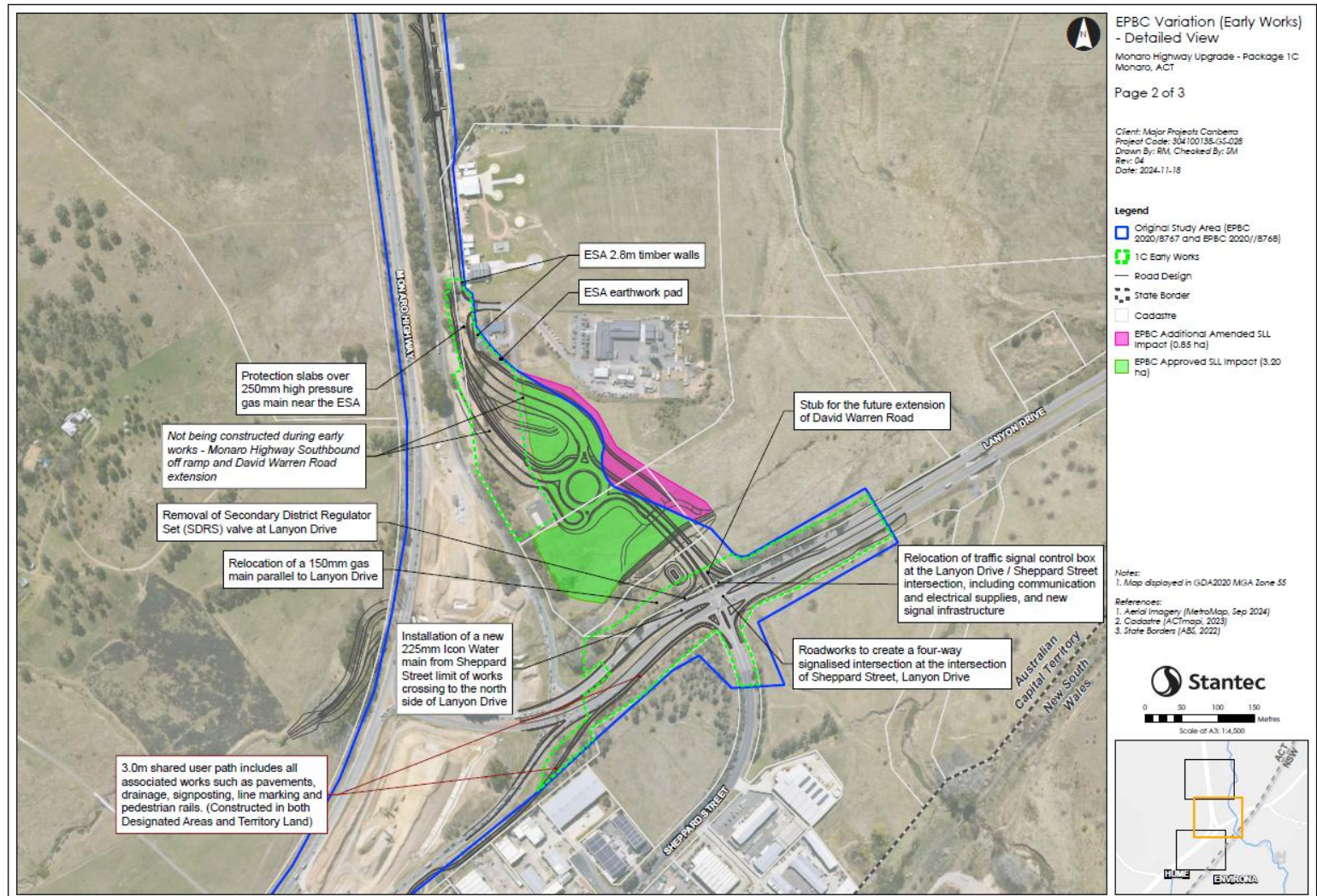

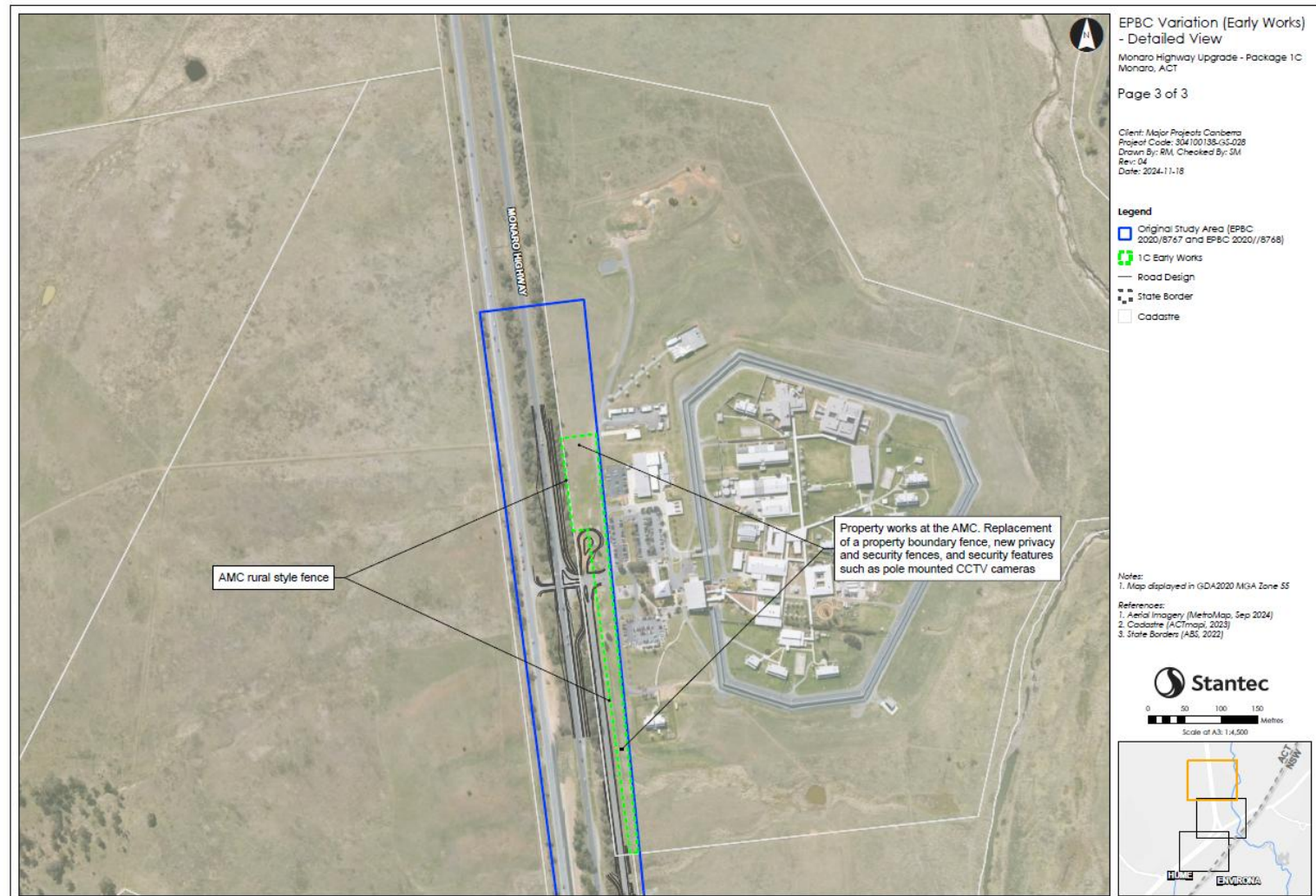

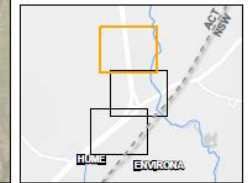
