

**PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION FOR ASSESSMENT ON PRELIMINARY DOCUMENTATION UNDER SECTION 95(3) OF THE ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AND BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION ACT 1999 (EPBC Act)**

**Turner River Solar Hub [2025/10163]**

Pilbara Energy (Generation) Pty Ltd

Pilbara Energy (Generation) Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Fortescue Ltd (Fortescue) is proposing to develop the Turner River Solar Hub (the Proposed Action) approximately 120 km south of Port Hedland in the Pilbara Region of Western Australia.

The Proposed Action was determined to be a Controlled Action on 7 July 2025 under the EPBC Act and will be assessed through Preliminary Documentation. The relevant matters protected by Part 3 (s18 and 18A) of the EPBC Act are listed threatened species and communities including:

- Northern Quoll (*Dasyurus hallucatus*) (Endangered)
- Greater Bilby (*Macrotis lagotis*) (Vulnerable).

Pursuant to Section 95(2) of the EPBC Act, Fortescue invited public comments on the Proposed Action and the following published material:

- Preliminary Documentation Report (EPBC 2025/10163). This included the original referral documentation and associated attachments.

The published material was made available for public comment from **4 August 2025 to 29 August 2025**. **Fortescue would like to notify the public that no comments were received during the public comment period.**

Under Section 95B(4) of the EPBC Act, the Preliminary Documentation Report (EPBC 2025/10163) material will be re-published for a period of ten business 10days for viewing only at
