**Wagyl Kaip and Southern Noongar – Noongar Standard Heritage Agreement (NSHA) Activity Notice (AN) – Nyabing Road Widening**

We refer to the above-mentioned AN, issued to the South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council (**SWALSC**) on 25/08/2022.

**AN Response (ANR) under clause 8.3 of the NSHA.**

Reasons to support the assessment are:

- The Proponent has committed to engaging monitors to manage any potential risks to Aboriginal heritage values
- There is a known Aboriginal cultural heritage site within the Activity Area

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic:

- Prior to the Survey or Monitoring commencement date, all Consultant participants must be provided with a hardcopy of the contracted Aboriginal Heritage Service Provider's health and safety policy and procedure, in particular as it relates to COVID-19;
- The Proponent and/or Aboriginal Heritage Service Provider will ensure that all participants adhere to current social distancing directives of government, including during any travel on buses or other vehicles arranged by the Proponent or Aboriginal Heritage Service Provider;
- Make available to all Consultant/Monitor participants with appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE). Wearing of PPE will be at the discretion of the participants;
