Good afternoon Peter,

I hope you're doing well and enjoying the beautiful spring weather during your bike rides.

To revisit our last meeting about the Wattle Hill Creek Bridge Replacement Project, I've submitted our draft civil design plans for GHCMA's review ahead of the final approval. You had requested information on the amount of fill being placed on the western side of the bridge.

The DTP design team is now close to finalising the design, and they have provided the details. Attached is a plan that highlights the additional fill required for the existing embankment. The estimated fill volume is approximately 25 m³. It's assumed that the flood zone affects the upstream area and the left-hand side batter only.

Please note that most of the proposed roadworks will be sitting above the existing roadway and therefore matching into the top of existing embankments.

Moving forward, please let me know if you require any further information from our side to endorse the draft plans. Alternatively, if you're satisfied with the current details, we are happy to proceed and submit the final plans for official review and approval once they're ready.

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Good morning Peter,

Thanks for your email below.

DTP is currently making minor amendments to the previously issued design for GHCMA due to funding constraints.

- **New Bridge Height:** The new bridge design height will be the same as the current bridge over Wattle Hill Creek on Henty Hwy. The current lowest point of the bridge deck is on the south side, and according to the new grade levels, the new lowest point of the proposed bridge will be on the north side at the current lowest point level.
- **Kerb:** The kerb on the structure was removed due to the 4% crossfall grade on the bridge deck.

DTP is seeking GHCMA's endorsement to proceed with the final design, including these minor amendments.

Please let me know if you have any further queries regarding the design. I'm happy to arrange a meeting with the DTP design team and CMA if required.
